Program Components

Drug testing is conducted a minimum of ten times per month; Narcotics Anonymous and sponsor involvement; Moral Reconation Therapy; individual, group, family, women's and other specialty counseling groups; Advisory Board comprised of judges, drug court coordinator, district attorney, public defender, treatment representative, neighborhood association representatives, Albuquerque Police Narcotics Lieutenant, and the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Department Narcotics Lieutenant.

Additional Information

Drug court probation officers work closely with the Albuquerque Police Department and the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Department on a number of issues. The drug court also supplies community service to neighborhood associations and community centers. The Bernalillo County Detention Center allows drug court clients to enter a 28-day "Addiction Treatment Program" if recommended by Drug Court Probation Officer and Judge.

Program Components

Face to face interviews to determine eligibility, intensive supervision pending eligibility and induction, psychological evaluations, crisis intervention, treatment referrals/monitoring/compliance, clinical staffing with providers, case management, urine drug screens, 12-step meetings (AA, NA), Judicial Review, team case staffing, case review with the Judges, graduation and step down supervision; follow up/monitoring for two years after completion.

Additional Information

The Second Judicial District Court and Pretrial Services Division in conjunction with the District Attorney's and Public Defender's office piloted a mental health court in 2003 with the focus on decriminalizing individuals with mental health disorders while providing an avenue for accountability, treatment, quality of life and public safety. The first Judicial Review was held on October 31, 2003 with five participants. Funding was appropriated by the NM Legislature in 2005. Participants are in the program for a minimum of twelve (12) months and up to three (3) years depending on the charges, prior history and treatment compliance. Clients are inducted into the program through diversion, plea or sentencing agreement; are in active supervision and appear before the Judge on a monthly basis. After successfully completing the first phase of the program, clients continue to be supervised through a stepdown process to ensure continued compliance with treatment and medication in order to transition participants to their natural support systems. Clients graduate from the program; then are sent back to the assigned judge for sentencing. Collaboration and cooperation among judges, prosecutors, public defenders, defense attorneys, family members, employers, probation authorities, law enforcement, other judicial jurisdiction and entities, treatment providers, educational and vocational agencies, housing programs, and case management systems must occur to ensure the participant's success. Participants must be competent to stand trial; and their case must in whole or part, be prosecutable. JSP is a voluntary program. The SJDC Pretrial Services Division provides Jail Diversion services to individuals with severe persistent mental health disorders; Pretrial Supervision to adults charged with felony offenses; and background investigations in addition to JSP.

Strength based model with four phases including Intensive Outpatient substance abuse treatment, parenting classes and family activities, group and individual counseling, Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT), frequent and random drug testing through urinalysis and oral swab testing, home visitation, community service monitoring and once a month judicial reviews. Presently the program positions are vacant and the two surveillance officer positions are getting help of thirty hours a week from the Adult Drug Court Program to visit the program participants.

The FRC Program team consists of the FRC Program Staff program manager and two surveillance officers, CYFD Case Workers and Supervisor, Guardians Ad Litem, Respondent Attorney, a Citizen's Review Board member, CASA Director, Treatment Staff which at this time is NAVA Counseling services. The team is led by the Drug Court Judge. The team screens all referrals for participation eligibility. The team staffs all cases before judicial reviews to make recommendations on client progress; incentives/sanctions. The goal is to reunify a healthy functioning family through substance abuse recovery programming and judicial intervention.
