

AIN THE SUPREME COURT OF NEW MEXICO

IN THE MATTER OF THE ADOPTION OF
SECURITY INCIDENT REPORT AND
TELEPHONE THREAT FORM FOR USE IN
THE NEW MEXICO JUDICIAL BRANCH OF GOVERNMENT

ORDER

WHEREAS, between June 1998 and April 1999, the Supreme Court sponsored a ground-breaking project, an assessment of security provisions in the district and magistrate courts of the state;

WHEREAS, the project was carried out through on-site surveys of fifteen courts and a mail survey of more than 600 persons using and working in the state courts;

WHEREAS, the project results were reported in two stages, the first based on the site visits;

WHEREAS, the results described twenty-six (26) problems, recommended a solution for each, and proposed a strategy for achieving major improvements in the short term;

WHEREAS, the second stage of the project analyzed the results of a mail survey and added long term elements to the strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Statewide Security Committee for the Judicial Branch of Government recommends adoption of the attached security incident report form and telephone threat form, and the Court having considered said recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Pamela B.

Minzner, Justice Patricio M. Serna, Justice Richard C. Bosson, and Justice Edward L. Chávez concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recommendation hereby is ADOPTED and the attached security incident report form and telephone threat form hereby are APPROVED for use in the Judicial Branch of Government.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
